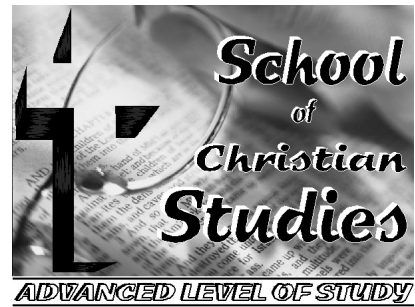

School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study



Thank you for your interest in the **School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study**. The advanced level of study, introduced in Spring 2005, will bring together classroom learning and practical ministry skills to provide a two-year course of study to give students the opportunity to study where they feel the greatest need and interest. The West Virginia Baptist Convention **School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study** is open to all persons, though current students enrolled in the School of Christian Studies may wish to preserve their time and energy and complete the basic courses in the School of Christian Studies first. Anyone may take courses and it is not necessary to be a teacher, youth worker or pastor to benefit from this advanced level of study. Classes are led by qualified instructors who must meet certain criteria in order to teach. Our instructors have experience in the classes they are leading and have great knowledge of the day to day ministry of the church.

At this time, there is one program of study in the **School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study** and that is the 2-year Advanced Level of Study Program. If a certificate of completion is not desired, you may wish to audit the program for a reduced rate. Eight of the Advanced Level Courses will be taught every two years on an ongoing basis. Once 8 courses are completed, a certificate of completion will be given. The selection of courses to be offered will be driven by:

- 1.) requests of students and
- 2.) disciplines needed for well-rounded ministry as determined by the deans and director with input by leading pastors and potential presenters.

The **School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study** carries no college or seminary credit, but it does provide creditable and recognizable training within the convention family.

Fees: Fees for the **School of Christian Studies Advanced Level of Study** are very affordable and a reduced rate is available for those who do not wish to receive credit. Each class will be \$28.50/single or \$40.00/couple, plus the cost of the textbook and shipping fee. Textbook and shipping costs will be published in the mailing sent out one month prior to each class. If you wish only to audit the course, you may pay a fee of \$14.25/single or \$25.00/couple and purchasing a textbook and completing assignments is not required. If you later decide you want to receive credit for the class, you may take it when it becomes available again and you must pay the full cost and complete all assignments.

Classes: Classes will be in a one-day format, with four classes being taught every year, for a total of eight classes in the two-year program. The classes will take place at our West Virginia Baptist Conference Center in Ripley, West Virginia. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m., with class starting at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m. Lunch will be provided, along with snacks upon your arrival in the morning. Break times will be designated by the instructor.

Please bear with us as we are in the beginning stages of our new level of study. There is much to do when starting from scratch. We continue to plan, gather and format information to be passed on to you. Some of our information may be incomplete at this time, but we will keep you informed of any new information. Please keep all staff involved with this new level of study in your prayers as we continue to provide you with the information you are so eager and willing to learn about.
